Japan's Ansei (安政) era spanned from 1854 to 1860. During this time, as trade between Nagasaki (Japan's famous 'Window to the West') and the outside world continued to grow, numerous foreign businesses – along with western-style hotels – sprang up around the port. Entertainment and services which the Japanese had never previously encountered appeared; there was thus an emerging trend of 'new culture' to stimulate the intellectual curiosity.

In the present day, in a place with such deep (and assorted) cultural roots as Nagasaki, global architect Mr Kengo Kuma develops the "GARDEN TERRACE NAGASAKI HOTELS & RESORTS". We will reshape hotel culture, pioneering a new kind of hotel where guests will truly experience the best of everything from intimate shared dinner and luxurious overnight stay, to the wedding-of-a-lifetime.

Kengo Kuma was born in Yokohama, Japan in 1954. After completing a Master's degree in Architecture at the university of Tokyo in 1979, he established "Kengo Kuma & Associates" in 1990. He has been awarded many prizes in Japan as well as overseas.


A resort-like area adjacent to the swimming pool.
